Explore: Military Life at the Fort – When the Fort was alive in 1848, discipline was a way of life. Walk through the stations, each with a lesson to teach about how hardship can bring us to a great sense of happiness when we work together.

Explore: Drovers and Cattle Trails- Drovers (Cowboys and Cowgirls) were always passing through the Fort with their spirit of determination and camaraderie. The stations will give participants a glimpse into what their life was like on the open range.

July 24 9 am – 2:30 pm

Explore: Pioneer Family Life- The pioneers who built the community of Fredericksburg played an important role at the Fort. Perseverance guided them through difficulties. Stations will teach the life of those that went before us here in Fredericksburg.
