### 1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Kiehne called the regular meeting of the Fredericksburg City Council to order at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, May 10, 2021. Mayor Kiehne announced a quorum of the City Council present.

The City Council reviewed the Tally Sheets from the May 1, 2021 General Election.


