

The City of Fredericksburg Engineering Department, in accordance with National Flood Insurance Program regulation in 44CFR Sec 65.7(b)(1), hereby gives notice of the City's intent to revise the flood hazard information generally located between S. Adams Street and S. Washington Street. Specially, the flood hazard information will be revised along Barons Creek from approximately 80 feet downstream of S. Lincoln Street right-of-way upstream to a point approximately 1,300 feet upstream of South State Highway 16 (S. Adams Street).

As a result of the LOMR, the regulatory floodway will widen and narrow, the 1-percent-annual chance water surface elevations will increase and decrease, and the 1-percent-annual-chance floodplain of Barons Creek will widen and narrow within the area of revision.
